

And to the end you may be so much the more holpen by that good Spirit which hath moved you thereunto, he granteth unto you his blessing, plenary indulgence, and remission of all your sins, according to your request. Assuring you, that beside the merit that you shall receive therefore in heaven, his holiness will further make himself debtor. to acknowledge your deservings 250 in the best manner that he can; and so much the more, in th...
