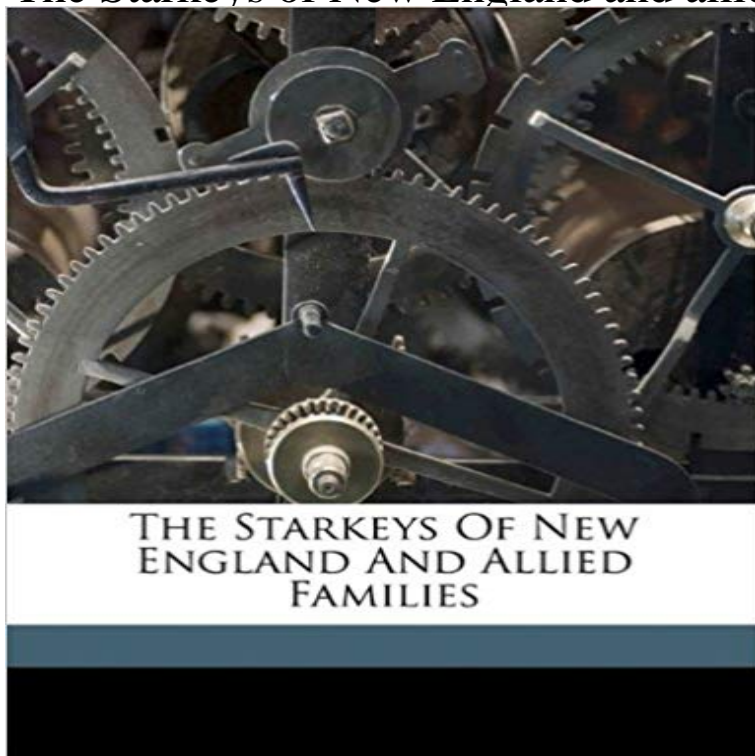


The Starkeys of New England and allied families
