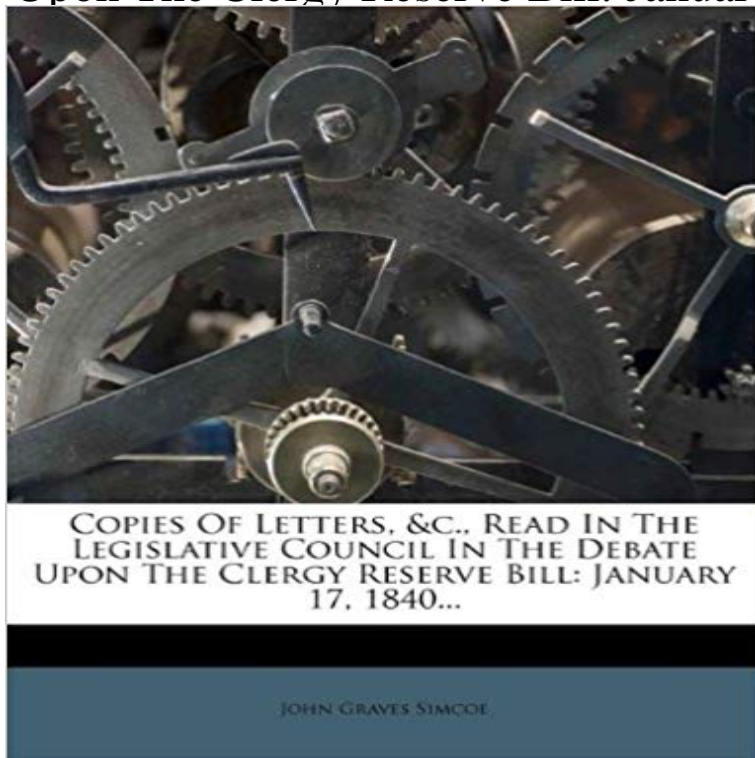


Copies Of Letters, &c., Read In The Legislative Council In The Debate Upon The Clergy Reserve Bill: January 17, 1840...
