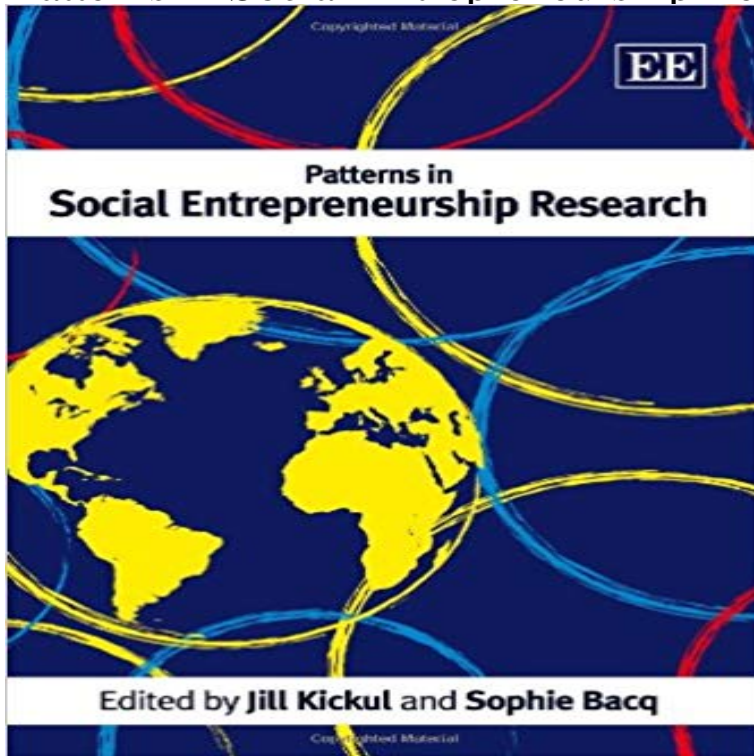


Patterns in Social Entrepreneurship Research
